A really great start to your netball careers!



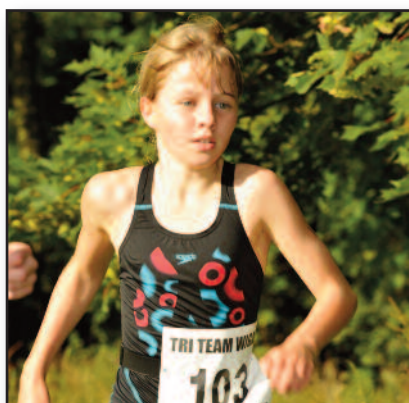
Mixed Results for Football Teams
